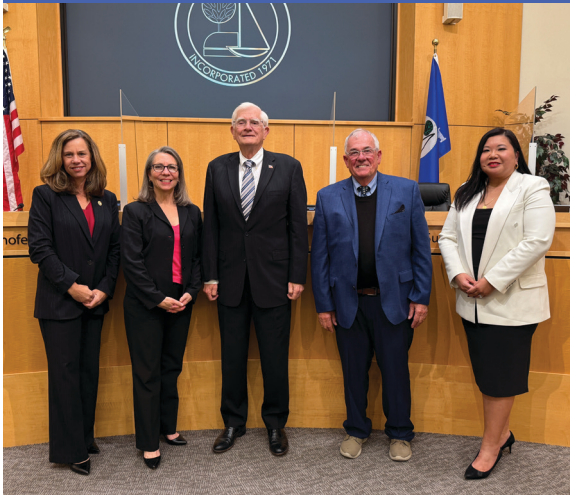

Hard to Dispose Items

- **Bulky Items:** From February through December (by appointment), single family residents can call Recology at 650-595-3900 to schedule up to two no-cost collections per year. Multi-family residents coordinate collection events through their property managers. Appointments based on availability.
- **Household Batteries:** Single family residents can place batteries in a zipper bag on the black garbage cart on collection day. Multi-family property managers can request free battery buckets from Recology for common areas. Or find a collection site at rethinkbatteries.org.
- **Household Hazardous Waste:** Make a free drop-off appointment at www.smchealth.org/hhw-appt.
- **Medications:** Find medication disposal locations at 844-633-7765 or med-project.org/locations/san-mateo
