## WATER & WASTEWATER RATE ADJUSTMENTS

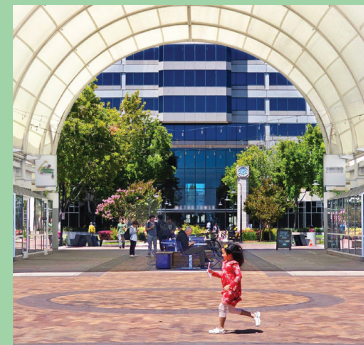

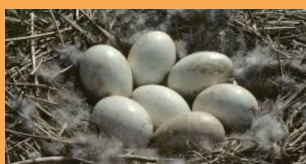

Community members are encouraged to help the City's goose mitigation efforts by reporting goose nests via the Foster City Access app. Reporting goose nests helps the City track activity

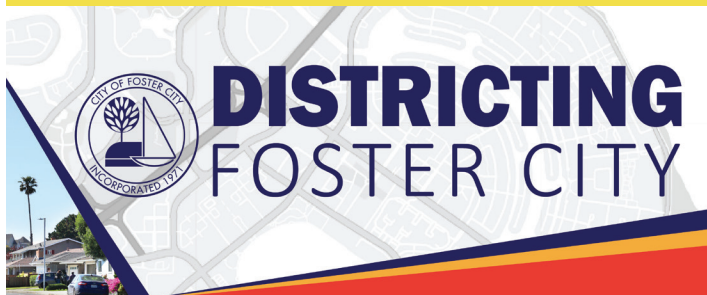
and manage the Canada goose population in a safe, humane, and effective way. Learn more about the Canada Goose Management Plan:
