### E-Waste Drop-Off

**ACCEPTABLE ITEMS** – TVs, computers, printers, monitors, laptops, cables/cords, cell phones, MP3 and DVD players, and more (working or not).

**UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS** – household appliances like fans, floor heaters, smoke detectors, vacuum cleaners, dishwashers, ovens, stoves, refrigerators, freezers, or any household hazardous waste.

### Document Shredding

San Mateo residents can bring up to a **MAXIMUM of 3 standard banker boxes** for secure on-site destruction

- Maximum box size: 10”x12”x15”
- Staples and paper clips are okay
- Proof of residency required

*Event lasts until the time listed or until the truck is full, whichever comes first.*

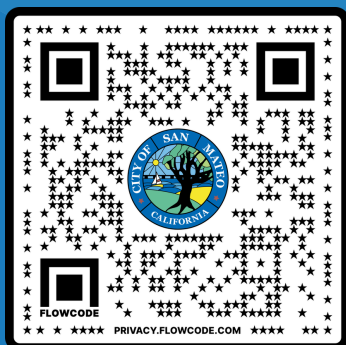
Your unique perspective will help guide the City Council and staff in making well-informed decisions that benefit and improve the City of San Mateo.
