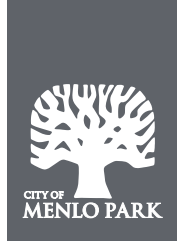


# ENVIRONMENTAL UPDATES



## NEW SOLID WASTE RATE EFFECTIVE JULY 1

A solid waste rate study to evaluate the cost of landfill, recycling and organics collection, processing and disposal services was completed. The City Council adopted five-year solid waste rates on June 9 and the new rates will be in effect beginning on July 1 through June 30, 2031.

The table below shows the monthly rates being considered for single-family residential customers for each year by container size. The base monthly rates include the following solid waste services:

- Weekly pickup of garbage, recycling and organic material
- Two free on-call bulky item collection services per year
- Curbside holiday tree collection service
- Single-stream recycling using a blue cart to recycle glass, metal cans, aluminum, cartons, non-food soiled paper and cardboard, small scrap metal and plastic bottles and containers
- Residential composting program using the green cart for items such as yard waste, food scraps (meat, cheese, fruits and vegetables, etc.) and food soiled paper products, such as pizza boxes, paper drink cups, paper plates and paper napkins.

## SOLID WASTE AND WATER DISCOUNT PROGRAM

The City of Menlo Park offers a rate assistance program that provides eligible households with a 20% monthly discount on solid waste service from Recology San Mateo County and a monthly discount on the fixed meter charge for water service from Menlo Park Municipal Water. Current participants do not need to reapply.

To be eligible for this program, households must be enrolled in the PG&E California Alternative Rates for Energy (CARE) program, which is another discount program that offers a monthly minimum of 20% on gas and electricity. La Ciudad de Menlo Park ofrece un programa de asistencia de tarifa. Los hogares calificados pueden recibir un descuento mensual del 20% en el servicio de residuos sólidos de Recology San Mateo County y un descuento mensual en el cargo del medidor fijo del servicio de agua de Menlo Park Municipal Water. Los hogares ya inscritos no necesitan presentar otra solicitud.

Para ser elegible para este programa, los hogares deben estar inscritos en el programa PG&E CARE, este es otro programa de descuento que ofrece un mínimo mensual del 20% en gas y electricidad. ## POPULAR DOCUMENT SHREDDING EVENT IS BACK

City Corporation Yard (333 Burgess Ave., Menlo Park)

Residents can prevent identity theft by shredding sensitive documents at the City's popular free shredding event. Confidential document destruction includes items such as receipts, checks, pre-approved credit applications, credit card statements, outdated tax returns, pre-printed envelopes, return address labels and business cards.

Participants are limited to three boxes (10" x 12" x 15") per vehicle and materials will be shredded on-site. Documents with paper clips and staples are acceptable.

This event is first come, first served. Please do not bring any e-waste or household hazardous waste materials. Please follow these guidelines for smoother drop-off service:

- Please label "Shred only" on any shredding materials and leave them in the trunk.
- Remove all other personal items from the trunk to avoid any accidents.
- Open your trunk prior to driving up to the vendors and remain in your vehicle. Vendors will pick up the shredding materials from the trunk.

RethinkWaste and Recology San Mateo County are teaming up with the City of Menlo Park to encourage residents to properly recycle old electronics. Accepted items include TVs, computers, printers, monitors, cables/cords, cell phones, MP3 players, DVD players, laptops (working or not) and more. Items that will not be accepted include household appliances, such as fans, floor heaters, smoke detectors, vacuum cleaners, cooktops, dishwashers, microwaves, ovens, stoves, refrigerators, freezers or household hazardous waste.

Proof of residency may be required. This event is first come, first served, and will only be available until the end time, until the trucks are full or while supplies last.

## NEW ELECTRIC VEHICLE (EV) CHARGING RATES EFFECTIVE JULY 1

Following City Council approval of the updated Master Fee Schedule on April 28, updated EV charging fees will take effect July 1, at City-operated charging stations:

- Level 2 chargers: \$0.41 per kWh
- Level 3 chargers: \$0.51 per kWh
- The \$5 per hour overstay fee after three hours will remain in effect
- The \$0.50 charging access fee will be removed
