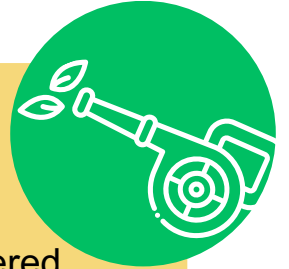

Phasing out Gas-Powered Leaf Blowers

Assembly Bill 1346: Gas-Powered Leaf Blowers Phase-Out



California's Assembly Bill 1346 bans the sale of new gas-powered leaf blowers in the State. The law aims to reduce emissions and noise from the use of gas-powered leaf blowers.

City of San Carlos Electric Leaf Blower Rebate Program



To ease the transition from gas to electric leaf blowers, the City of San Carlos is providing rebates to residents and businesses for the purchase of electric leaf blowers.

How Can You Help?

Consider the following sustainable alternatives:

- Rake and bag leaves whenever possible
- Compost leaves to reduce waste
- Pledge to "Let Leaves Lie" to promote soil health (information on back)
- Switch to electric leaf blowers by taking advantage of the City's rebate program (information on back)
- Ask your gardener to adopt the practices above or lend your electric leaf blower to them for use

Phasing out Gas-Powered Leaf Blowers

Electric Leaf Blower Rebate For Residents

San Carlos residents are eligible for a rebate of up to \$100 off one newly purchased electric leaf blower and associated battery. Limit of one rebate per household.



Electric Leaf Blower Rebate for Businesses

Businesses with an active San Carlos business license are eligible for a rebate of up to \$500 off an electric leaf blower and associated batteries. Limit of two rebates per active San Carlos business license per year.



Let Leaves Lie Pledge

As leaves break down, they provide rich nutrients for your lawn. Letting the leaves build up under trees and shrubs provides a nature-based alternative to blowing leaves away. Join other residents in signing the Let Leaves Lie pledge by visiting cityofsancarlos.org/LeavesPledge.
